UPON

reading this day at the Board a Presentment from the Court of her Majestys Customs Relating to Colonel Quary Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> of the Southern Continent of America who about twelve years ago obtained Judgment in Maryland upon four bonds in the penalty of one thousand £ each for illegal Trade carrying the unmerited Goods in the plant<sup>s</sup> to Foreign Parts and that he had severall times applied to the Governour and Councill to get Execution Levied but to no purpose they having referred him to the attorney Gen<sup>l</sup> who constantly put him off under one pretence or another Her Majesty in her privy Councill taking notice of these proceedings is pleased to order as it is hereby ordered that the Governour or Commander in Chief and the Councill of her Majestys province of Maryland as also the attorney Gen<sup>l</sup> there, doe without any further delay what so ever cause Execution to be Levied according to the said Judgment and that due prosecution be made on the severall bonds w<sup>ch</sup> the said Col<sup>l</sup> Quary has given or shall give to the said attorney Gen<sup>l</sup> to be put in Suite as being forfeited for Breaching Contrary to Law. Whereof they are not to fail at their perills and the said Governour or Commander in Chief or Councill of her Majesty said province of Maryland the attorney Gen<sup>l</sup> there and to take, as well as all other persons concerned are to take due notice here of and to be aiding and assisting to the said Col<sup>l</sup> Quary accordingly.
