The Receipt whereof he the said John Easterling Doth hereby
acknowledge and thereof and therefrom acquit exonerate
and Discharge the said Preragune Browne his Exors and
adms and every of them by these presents and for diverse other
good causes & Contentment them the said John Easterling
and Henricitta his wife Honourably & lawfully granted
Bargained Sold aliened enfeoffed Released & Confirmed &
By these presents Do grant bargain & sell alien enfeoff. Give
and Confirm unto the said Preragune Browne All
that the one moyety or halfe pte of all y^e tract
or piece of Land situate lying & being in Calumore
County Called Broomes Bloom originally taken up and
pattined by John Browne father of y^e said Henricitta
and by him given and Bequeathed to Henricitta his wife
beginning at a bounded plot being a bounded
(Sua)
