The following deed of Gift recorded at request of Mr. Peyton Warman of Calvert County

Know all men by these presents that John Green of Trade River in the County of Annapundell in the province of Maryland Planter do from and my heirs & assigns hereby freely give & bequeath unto Francis Walth a parcel of Land lying in Calvert County in the River in head and Neck Harbour being one hundred and I do hereby promise the peaceable enjoyment thereof to him the said Francis Walth his heirs or assigns for ever from and my heirs & assigns as witness my hand this 19th day of April 1671
