

This Indenture made this Seventh day of November In the Tenth  
 Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Anne Queen of Great Britain &c  
 Annoq<sup>ue</sup> Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eleven Between Charles  
 Beckwith of St. Marys County Shipwright of the one part and Amos Garrett  
 of the City of Annapolis in the Province of Maryland Merchant of the other  
 part Witnesseth that the said Charles Beckwith for and in consideration  
 of Thirty Seven pounds Eighteen Shillings and Six pence Stere to him in  
 hand paid by the said Amos the receipt whereof the said Charles Beckwith  
 doth here by acknowledge and thereof doth fully discharge the said Amos  
 his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> and Adm<sup>ors</sup> Hath bargained unto him the said Amos Garrett all  
 those two severall parcels of Land being part of a certain Tract of Land  
 containing about five thousand Seven hundred Acres called  
 Lying near Chespeak Bay and at or near St. Jeroms and Originally taken up  
 by Capt. Wm Hawley and Lying in St. Marys County one of the parts  
 aforesaid being that parcel of Land whereon the said Charles Beckwith  
 now liveth and containeth two hundred Acres or thereabouts  
 the other part being a parcel of the said Great Tract heretofore purchased  
 by Wm Guither from Thomas Williams and by the said Guither made over  
 to the said Beckwith known by the name of Hogg Neck containing likewise  
 two hundred Acres more or less with all and singular the appurtenances  
 to the same or to any of them belonging as also three Negro Slaves Packaged  
 about Twenty Eight years Isabella aged about twelve years and Katherine  
 aged about one year and also sixteen head Cattle viz<sup>t</sup> of Cows heifers Steers  
 and a Bull none under a year old being all the said Charles Beckwiths  
 Cattle on the plantation called Mark a frog the right  
 ear and a swallow for the left and also twenty seven old Sheep and  
 Ten Lambs Memorandum for of above said was formerly  
 conveyed and made over to Charles Carrol and Amos Garrett for about  
 one hundred pounds Stere advanced the s<sup>d</sup> Charles Beckwith being  
 marked as aforesaid & if any of the s<sup>d</sup> Live Creatures should Dy or be  
 left before Drowd of the s<sup>d</sup> plantation by of s<sup>d</sup> Amos Garretts order he y<sup>e</sup>  
 s<sup>d</sup> Charles Beckwith hereby obliges himself his Ex<sup>ors</sup> or Adm<sup>ors</sup> to make other
