 pence being money of Great Brittain by good bills of exchange to the liking of the said
 Amos Garrett or his or some other person or persons to be named in London in Great Brittain
 and the said bills of exchange to be there duly accepted and to the said Amos Garrett
 or order at twenty days sight that then the deed in every clause and article therein
 and the Statute therein made to case determined be void to all intents and purposes
 otherwise the deed be and continue in force and effect as if the proviso had never been
 made on & in witness whereof the said parties hereunto interchangably sett to their hands
 and affixed their seals the day & year first above written Charles Beckwith (Sealed)
