had more fully and at large appears. And his  
present Majesty King George having approved  
the appointment of You the Said Charles Calvert to  
be Lieutenant and Chief Governour of the Said  
Province Know therefore that The Said  
Lord Baltimore and The Said Francis Lord  
Guilford Guardian of the Said Lord Baltimore  
on his behalf proposing Special trust and Con-  
fidence in Your Loyalty Courage Prudence  
and Conduct HAVE by Virtue of the Powers  
given in and by the Said Letters Patent and  
approbation aforesaid Constituted Nominated  
and appointed And by these presents Do Con-  
stitute Nominate and appoint You the Said  
Charles Calvert to be Lieutenant and Chief  
Governour of the Said Province of Maryland  
GIVING and hereby Granting You full and Absolute  
Power and Authority to Exercise Execute and put in  
Practice all and every the Said Powers Jurisdictions  
and Authorities so Granted in and by the Said Letters  
Patents as aforesaid Necessary and convenient for  
the Defence Safety Preservation well being and good  
Governing of the Said Province and Generally to do  
Execute and perform all and all manner of Mat-  
ters and things whatsoever requisite and Necessary  
for the good Order of Government Administering  
Maintaining and Executing of Justice and for  
the Security Defence Safety Peace and preserva-  
tion of the Said Province and people hereby com-  
mitted to Your Charge And also with the  
Consent
