 Considerations them the s^d. Henry Love & Mary
 his wife there unto Moving that he Given
 Granted Bargained Sold Aliened Confeid and
 Confirmed & by these presents doth give grant
 Bargain sell Alian Confeid & Confirm unto the said
 Bennett Love his heirs & assigns for ever
 also that Tract or piece of Land containing
 by Patent One thousand & four acres called
 Park Hall lying in the fork or the westernmost Branch
 of the head of Potomac River and adjoining to the
 Westward Side of a parcel of Land formerly taken up
