Tripartite made the thirteenth day of  
April Anno Domini 1716 and in the second year of  
the reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the  
grace of God King of Great Britain France  
and Ireland Defender of the Faith &c. Sir  
Margaret Browne of St. Dunstons Stepney London  
Widow and Exec. of the last will & Testament of  
Perceval Browne late of London Merchant deceased  
& Joseph Browne eldest son of the sd. Perceval &  
Margaret Browne of the first part Henry  
Ferne Esq. Receiver General & Sheriff of  
his Majestys Customs at the Port of London.  
On the second part And Maurice  
Burchfield Esq. Surveyor General  
of the Southern Continent of America  
Rich. Bennett Esq. of the Province  
of Maryland & the sd. Joseph Browne being  
assent nominated & appointed by all of them the  
sd. Marg. and Joseph Browne & the sd. Henry Ferne  
in Trust and for the purposes hereafter  
mentioned on the Third part Whereas  
the sd. Perceval Browne in his lifetime  
became indebted to the Crowne in Divers  
& severall Sums of Money amounting together
