and Seven Pence to Convey and assure unto the
Said Henry Perne and his Heirs in trust to and
for the use of his Majesty and his Success-
ors two full and equal thirds Parts (the whole
in three Equal Parts to be Devide) of all
and singular the Lands and tenements of the
Said Peregrine Browne herein after particularly
Mentioned and Expreseed Situate lying and being
in the Province of Maryland as the same
shall
