said Mary Wicks for and in Consideration of the Sum  
of Thirty Pounds Sterling money of Great Britains  
to her the said Mary in hand paid by the said Richard  
Bennett att and before the enswearing and delivery of  
these presents the Receipt whereof she the said Mary  
doth hereby acknowledge and confesse and herselfe to be  
therewith fully satisfied contented and paid and thereof  
and from every part and parcel thereof doth for herselfe  
her heires Exors. and Administrators and for every  
of them fully clearly and absolutely acquitt exonerate
