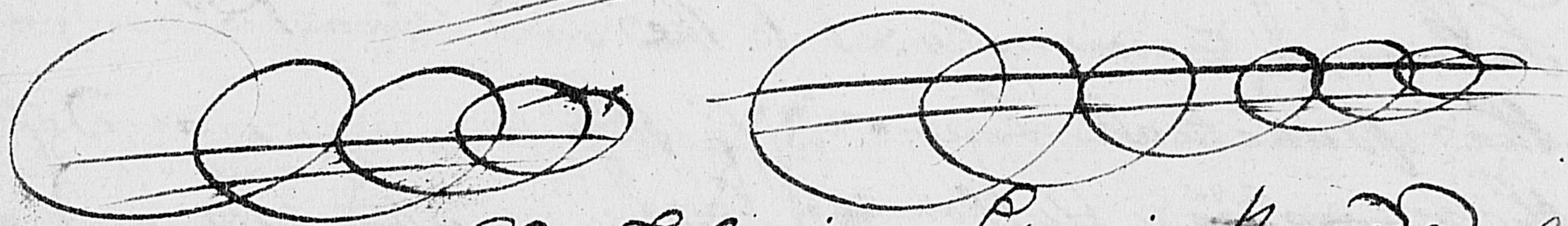


One hundred p^{ro} rata for a greater or lesser quantity
