

39. This Indenture Made the fifteenth Day of  
October Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and Eighteen  
years between Alexander Reid some time of Juror,  
the wester in the parish of Airdrie ~~now~~ <sup>then</sup> in  
the County of Aberdeen Johnsen Colclough of whole  
Blood and Siral Laule George Reid late of Saltbr  
County in the province of Murray and Gentleman  
Dores of the One part and John Reid Merchant in  
Aberdeen of the Other part. Whereas the said George Reid  
in his life time to witt the twenty fourth Day of March  
Anno Domini Sixteen hundred fifty Nine was seized  
in fee simple of certain parcels of Land called  
Reid bowles lying on the East Side of the said River  
and on the East Side of a River in the said County called  
Chester River lying in Queen Anne's County beginning  
at a marked Oak standing by a marsh as by the  
points to the west running North East up the River for  
breadth five hundred perches to a marked Spruce tree by  
which is called the Herring creek bounded on the south by  
a line drawn South East and by East from the first marked  
Oak by the Marsh for length three hundred perches on  
the East by a line drawn North East from the end of the  
said Oak and by East until it intersects a parallel  
drawn from the creek called the Herring creek on the  
north side of the said creek on the west side of the said River  
Containing and now laid out for one thousand acres of  
Land more or less. And whereas the said George Reid
