part Witnesseth that the said Charles and Rachel

fifty pounds Stere to them in hand paid by the said Thomas
the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and
thereof and from every part and parcel thereof do
hereby fully and absolutely acquit Concede and Discharge
him the said Thomas his heirs Executors and Adminis-
trators have given granted bargained sold Aliened Enfeoffed
and Confirmed And so by these presents for themselves and
their heirs give grant bargain sold Alien Enfeoffed and
Confirm unto him the said Thomas Bodley his heirs
and Assignes for ever All that Tract or piece of Land
called Painters Post formerly to witt About the fourth
day of November Anno Domini One thousand six hundred and
seventy seven Surveyed and afterwards Resurveyed for a certain
Nicholas painter of St. Mary's County lying on the North
side of Sassafras River and Beginning according
to the Certificate of Resurvey thereof at a marked
Corner her Standing on a bank by a Valley near
