Smiths forest lying on the Easterly Side of Bay of
Chesapeake as in and by the said Deeds recorded
in the provincial Office may appear Now I know
that of the said Receipt Do for me & my heirs Remise
release and for Ever quit Claim of in and to the
said Lands and to the Equity of Redemption
of them or any part of them in Consideration of five
Shillings in hand paid also for Divers valuable
Consideration to me in hand paid heretofore by the
said John Hyde Receipt whereof I Doe hereby
Acknowledge to witness my hand & Seal this
1st Day of Aug: 1721
