

This Indenture made the Twenty first Day
of July in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred &
and twenty two by and between Alexander Herbet of Prince
George's County Gentleman and Mary his wife her before
Widow and Relict of Giles Blizard late of Charles County
Deceased of the one part, and Mary Frazer of Prince George's
County of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said
Giles Blizard at the time of his Death was Seized in
his Demesnes as of free Hold and in divers Tracts and
parcels of Land in Maryland And particularly
of One Tract of Land called Athelborough lying in
Baltimore County containing six hundred Acres And
Whereas the said Charles Blizard by his last Will and
Testament in writing And by him signed and sealed and
Declared in the presence of two sufficient Witnesses the
Sixth Day of December in the Year of Our Lord 1687
And duly proved the third Day of February following before
the Honble Col: Henry Darnall and Clement Hill Coffer Several
Other Devises by his said ^{exec} in the last place given and
bequeath all the Rest of his Estate both real and personal
~~left~~ to his beloved wife Mary Blizard the abovementioned
Tract of Land called Athelborough being part of said
Remaining Real Estate by which bequeath or Devise
the said Mary (who since intermarried w^t the aforesaid
Alexander Herbet) came to be possessed in free Simple of the
abovesaid Tract of Land: Now this Indenture further
witnesseth that as well for and in consideration of the
great love and affection they the said Alexander Herbet
and Mary his wife doth bear unto their Granddaughter
the aforesd Mary Frazer And the desire they have to Ad-
