



Sold Aliened Infeoffed Remiss Released and Confirmed and by these
presents both give grant bargain Sell Alien Infeoff Remiss
Release and Confirm unto him the said Thomas Worthington
his Heirs and Assigns for ever all that Tract or parcel of
Land called Ridgelys Rocks Lying on the Middle River of
Potomac
