 of the province of Maryland between George Drow of
 Baltimore County of the One part and Mr. Robert Lusby Sen
 of Anne County of the Other part Witnesseth that
 the said George Drow for a valuable consideration
 already paid and by me received have sold unto the
 said Robert Lusby Sen: his heirs and assigns a certain
 Tract of Land lying in Baltimore County W. I. Land
 being by vertue of a Warr: granted unto John Sen: of
 Baltimore County planter bearing date the Eighth
 Day of June One thousand six hundred and Sixty
 Eight which said Tract of Land of the said Geo: Drow
 hath given granted bargained sold aliened releas'd &
 confirmed and by these presents Doth give grant
 Bargain sell release Enjoyn and confirm unto the said
 Robert Lusby Sen: his heirs and assigns all that
 Tract and parcel of Land formerly known & called by
 the name of Chilbury hall lying on the North
 Side of a River in the said County called Bush
 River beginning at a bounded head Cack upon
 a Point of a Marsh near the head of the West
 (branch)
