 Day of October One thousand Seven hundred and
 Twenty two and the Eighth year of the Reign of our
 soon Lord George by the ~~Gods~~ Grace of God of Great
 Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith
 & Protector of the Protestants Collins of Duffin County and
 James Collins of Cecil County of the province of Maryland
 Planter of the One part and James Husband of Cecil
 County in the said Province planter of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said ~~husband~~ and James Collins for
 and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings
 of Lawfull Money of Great Britain to them in hand paid
 before the Ensealing and Delivery of these presents
 by the said James Husband the receipt whereof the
 said ~~husband~~ & James Collins Doth here by acknowledge
 & thereof Doth Acquitt and Discharge the said James
 Husband his heirs Ex. Adm. and assigns and every
 of them by these presents hath bargained & sold &
 by these presents Doth bargain and Sell unto the
 said James Husband his Ex. Adm. and assigns all that
 Tract or parcel of Land called Mount Pleasant
 lying and being in Cecil County and upon a branch of
 a brook called Sasapux brook Beginning at a marked
 Stake by a Branch and Running South West and by west
 for breadth One hundred & fifty perches to a marked
 (white)
