and Assignes for ever all my Right Title and Interest  
of four hundred acres of ~~land~~<sup>land</sup> of this Land within  
mentioned marked and bounded according to Survey more  
or less next adjoining to the Land of the Widow  
Cummings Northwardly and Southerly upon the Remainder  
of the said pattent he or they saying yearly the Rent  
within mentioned To this Agreement of have sold  
my hand this 5. 6. September 1654 -

Being equally divided The said Morgan to have three  
fourths and Tom Leeds our fourth part thereof for w<sup>ch</sup>  
Land of doe Acknowledge to have Received full payment  
and Satisfaction In Witness whereof I have set my hand  
third day of May 1664 - Richard Bennet
