27 Be it Remembered that George Dawson of New Castle in the said
County Gent^l aged about Sixty three years being solemnly sworn on the
holy Evangelists of Almighty God Depo^seth that on or about the
Year of Our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Eight a warrant
of Seizure being discovered by a certain William Houston late of the said
County Merchant dated for two thousand five hundred acres of land in the
Office of James Claypool Esq^r late Clerk & Surveyor of the said County
who at that time had lost the use of his Speech and sense which
warrant belonged to a certain Edward Green late of the said County -
Merchant Esq^r who had without known heirs or Relations in this
Country and the said warrant by means of the said William Hous-
ton came into the hands of William Long a Justice of the Peace of
this County who made Application to this Depo^sent that he, the
said Long and Depo^sent might forgoe & save from him the said
Edward Green to the said William Houston for the said land which the
said Depo^sent utterly Refused to comply with but some time after
wards to wit in or about the Year of Our Lord One thousand
