New Castle County in Pennsylvania Died and a certain George
Saboyne of the same Count that the said Mallias Vanbobber
asked him the said Deponent the Questions following First if he
the said Deponent ever knew One Edward Green late of New Castle
County and Edward to which this Deponent answered Yes if
a certain John Scott late of said New Castle County Died was not
this Deponent's reputed father to which he again answered in the
Affirmative if the said Green & Scott ever had any Dealings together
