for performance of the same as he the said Depovent thought (being
illiterate) and he the said Depovent signed an instrument of writing
which he took to be only an assignment for three or four hundred
Acres of Land as aforesaid to the said Vanbobbler for that the said Vanbobbler
pretended the same to him this Depovent who trusted to his honesty -
But he the said Depovent being afterwards informed that the said
tract contained 2500 Acres of Land had the Records of Newcastle
County aforesaid searched on which was found registered a Deed for two
thousand five hundred Acres of Land from Edward Green aforesaid to the
said John Scott of which he this Depovent obtained a Copy the said
Depovent further Depovent that afterwards inquiring of the said
Vanbobbler the reason of his imposing on him this Depovent in
affirming the said tract to contain three or four hundred Acres -
when the same contained 2500 he the said Vanbobbler answered that
it was true there was so many Acres in the said tract but that the same
was judged about ~~one hundred~~ one hundred pounds Mill Rent and
another time talking of the same matter the said Vanbobbler told
this Depovent that it was true the said tract contained 2500 Acres
but that it was all ~~save~~ sixty comprehended in his the said
Vanbobbler's Mannour - And further this Depovent saith that -
