 parcel of Land Called Quill Glass as afo<sup>re</sup> that is not  
 contained within the inclos and bounds of the Land  
 Conveyed for two hundred Sixty One p<sup>er</sup>cent part  
 of the Society unto the sd Thomas by Deeds bearing  
 dat here with as afo<sup>re</sup> to gether with all the improve  
 -ments there on and appurtenance there unto belong  
 -ing to the use and behoofe of the said Charles his  
 heirs and assigns To Have & To hold All that  
 part of Quill Glass Not included in the sd Charles  
 Deed or Conveyance to the said Thomas bearing date  
 here with as afo<sup>re</sup> His heirs and assigns forever
