

Marylands This Indenture Made the 24th Day of July in the year of our Lord God seventeen hundred and Twenty three Between William murphey of Baltimore County planter of the One parte and John Earnshaw of Annapundell County Farmer of the Other parte Witnesseth that the Said William murphey for and in Consideration of the Sum of ~~fifty~~ pounds Curr: money of Maryland to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and Delivery here of the receipt inshew'd the Said William murphey Doth her here byacknowledge and thereof and of Every parte thereof he Doth hereby for himselfe and his heires fully clearly and absolutely acquit Exonerate and Discharge the Said John Earnshaw his heires and assigns for ever Hath Given granted bargained Sold aliene Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents Doth here by for himselfe his heires Executors and Administrators Give Grant bargain sell alien Enfeoffe and confirm unto him the Said John Earnshaw his heires and assigns all that part or parcel of Land called or known by the name of Murphey's Adventure Lying and being in Baltimore County On the South Side of Patapsco River on the Draught of Marly Bridge Branch Beginning at a bounded Oak Standing near a branch and running West fifty
