 by Course of Law or otherwise from the said John Brich his &c. or  
 Apique the Negroes & personal Estate of or any part or parcel thereof that  
 they the person or persons so recovering the said Twenty Pounds as his or their  
 part of the said Righty Pounds shall refund the same Sum of twenty Pounds  
 sterling to him the said John Brich his heirs &c. or Apique And the said  
 John Brich for himself his heirs &c. and Apique Doth by these Presents  
 Covenant and Agree to &c. with the said Mary Eagle that he his &c. or  
 Apique will find & provide for the said Mary Eagle sufficient Meat -  
 Drink Washing Lodging and necessary Clothing during her life. And lastly  
 It is further Agreed by &c. between the Parties to these presents that in Case  
 the said Robert Eagle Salandine Eagle they or any of them, their heirs &c.  
 or Apique should recover the said Negroes and personal Estate or any  
 part or parcel thereof at any time before the before mentioned Children  
 respectively arrive at the Ages of Twenty One year that they in such  
 Case the Covenants Articles and Agreements in these Presents mentioned -  
 save that which relates to the Maintenance of the said Mary Eagle which  
 is to stand good during her life) and all of them (except as before excepted)  
 is to pass be made void and of no Effect, otherwise the whole is to  
 stand in full force & Virtue And in Testimony that both Parties are  
 Agreed & Contented w<sup>th</sup> what is before mentioned they have hereunto  
 set their hands & Seals this 26<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1721
