in the Year of our Lord God one thousand Seven hundred
and Nineteen Between Thomas Padgett of Prince
Georges County planter Son and Heir of Thomas Padgett
late of Calvert County Deceased and John Bagby of
Calvert County planter & Mary his Wife Daughter
& Heiress of one John Ford late of Calvert County
and Deed of the one part & William Meades and
John Meades both of Calvert County of the
other part Witnesseth that Whereas the said
Thomas Padgett the Son being seized & possessed
as heir to his father as aforesaid of & in a certain tract
or parcell of Land called St. Martins lying in
Talbot County on the North Side of Choptank
River in the Northern main branch of the S.
River called by the Name of Tuckahoe Creek
containing by estimation four hundred Acres
more or less did by his deed of Bargain & Sale
of part thereof bearing date the first day of No-
vember in the Year of our Lord 1703 Grant
Bargain Sell Alien Enfeoffed & confirm unto
the said John Ford in his lifetime for the con-
sideration of thirty pounds of Lawfull Mo-
ney of England to him the said Thomas Pad-
gett the Son in hand by him the said John
