Maryland Merchant and are worth to be Sold
the Sum of three thousand pounds of Lawfull
Money of Great Brittain And it was further
found by the Said Inquisition that the Said
Thomas Coutts in his own Right was possess of the
Ship or Vessel called the Wellcome Supply Bar-
-nard Townesend Master of the Burthen of
Tunns or thereabouts with her
Lackle and Apparell which Said Vessel did
at the time of taking the Said Inquisition re-
-main in the Custody of the aforesaid Barnard
Townesend and is worth to be Sold the Sum
of one thousand pounds of Lawfull Money
of Great Brittain All which Said Tobacco
and every part & parcell thereof and also all
