Now This Indenture Expressly Witnesseth that  
the Said Charles Todd for and in Consideration of the full  
Mociecie or sum of Thirty pounds Current Money of  
Maryland to him the Said Charles Todd in hand paid  
by the Said Charles Homewood the Receipt whereof the  
Said Charles Todd doth hereby acknowledge and himself  
therewith to be fully Clearly Absolutely Satisfied Contented  
and paid and therefrom and every part thereof doth  
acquit Exonorate and Discharge the Said Charles Homewood  
his Heirs Executors Administrators or Assignes and all
