That We Allen Davies John Moran & Henry Lyon of
Charles County in the Province aforesaid Gent. are held and firmly
bound unto the Right Honourable Frederick Absolute Lord and
Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron
of Baltimore in the Sum of Two hundred pounds Current money
to be paid to the said Lord Proprietary his heirs and successors To
which Payment well and truly to be made and done We bind
Ourselves and each of us Our and every of our heirs Executors
and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these Presents
for and in the whole seal'd with our seals and dated this First
day of November Anno Domini 1759.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such That if
the above bounded Allen Davies whilst he shall continue in
the Office of Receiver or Collector of the Land Tax in Charles
(County)
