all manner of Persons whatsoever to the Said Thomas Brooke Hodgkin his  
Heirs and Assigns Shall and will Wanant and forever defend by these presents  
and that he the Said Joseph Evitts and his Heirs shall and will at any time  
hereafter execute any further or other Deed Assurance or Conveyance that  
Shall be Devised Advised or Required by him the Said Thomas Brooke  
Hodgkin his Heirs or Assigns or his or their Council Learned in the Law  
for the further and better Assurance of the Premises to the Said Thomas  
Brooke Hodgkin his Heirs and Assigns so as aforesaid to bar in the most  
Effectual manner any Claim or Demand of him the Said Joseph Evitts or  
his Heirs or any other person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof
