This Indenture made this fourth day of July in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and Sixty Between David Jameson of the Town and County of York in the Colony of Virginia Merchant of the one Part and William Green of the City of Williamsburgh in the Colony of Virginia aforesaid Merchant of the other part Witnesseth that the said David Jameson for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings Sterling to him in hand paid by the said William Green the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Hath bargained and sold and by these Presents Doth bargain and sell unto the said William Green All that Lot of Ground lying and being in Baltimore Town in Baltimore County in the Province of Maryland distinguished in the Plat of the said Town by the Number fourteen lately occupied by a certain James Lary and by him sold and conveyed to him the said David Jameson together with all Edifices Buildings Gardens ways Waters Water Courses Commodities Priviledges Improvements Emoluments Advantages and Appurtenances whatsoever to the same Lot of Ground belonging or appurtenant and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents issues and Profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to Hold the said Lot of Ground and all and singular the Premises with their and every of their lights (Members)
