


 said George Slye with a pure and indefeasible Estate of Inheritance
 in fee Simple of and into the Lands aforesaid with the Appurtenances
 and for no other purpose whatever In Witness whereof the said Parties
 have hereto interchangeably Affixed their Hands and Seals this fourteenth
 day of September in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and
 fifty nine
