This Indenture Made this 24th day of February Anno
Domini one thousand seven hundred and fifty one between
John Mount of Baltimore County Shoemaker of the one part
and Rezin Hammonds of Annapundel County planter of the
other part Witnesseth that the said John Mount for and in
consideration of the sum of thirty four pounds Sterling
to him in hand paid by the said Rezin Hammonds the
Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and him self
satisfisly contented and paid hath given granted
Bargained and sold aliened Enjoined & confirmed and by
these presents doth give grant bargain Sell Alien Injoine
and confirm unto the said Rezin Hammonds his heirs
and assigns for ever two parts or Parcels of a Tract of
Land called Edwards Discovery lying and being in
Baltimore County Beginning for the first part
or parcel at the end of thirty fitches on the third
line of the aforesaid tract and running thence north
fifty degrees East one hundred and fifty three perches
to the End of the said Line then north six degrees East
seventy
