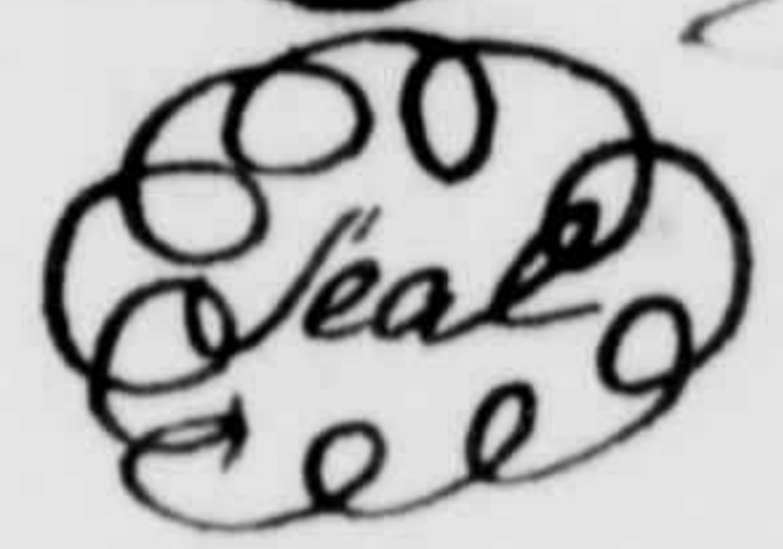


23) Yearly and every Year be let out at Interest - as soon as the same shall become due or shall be received and all the said Rents and Interest thereof shall be applied for and towards raising a proportion for Thomas Whittenhall Rozer the youngest Son of the said Henry and Elenor Rozer and all the Money & Profits so as aforesaid raised during the ^{minority or} Minoritys aforesaid shall be paid to him the said Thomas Whittenhall Rozer but if it should so happen that the sum of one thousand Pounds Current Money should be raised out of the Rents and Interests aforesaid before the said Edward and Henry Rozer shall attain their several Ages of Twenty one years then the Rents and Interests aforesaid that is to say such or so much of the said ^{rents &} Interests as shall be raised after the sum of one thousand pounds be fully made up and completed shall be equally divided between them the said Edward and Henry and their Eldest Brother Notley Rozer In Witness whereof the Parties to these Presents have hereunto set their Hands and Seals the day and Year first above written

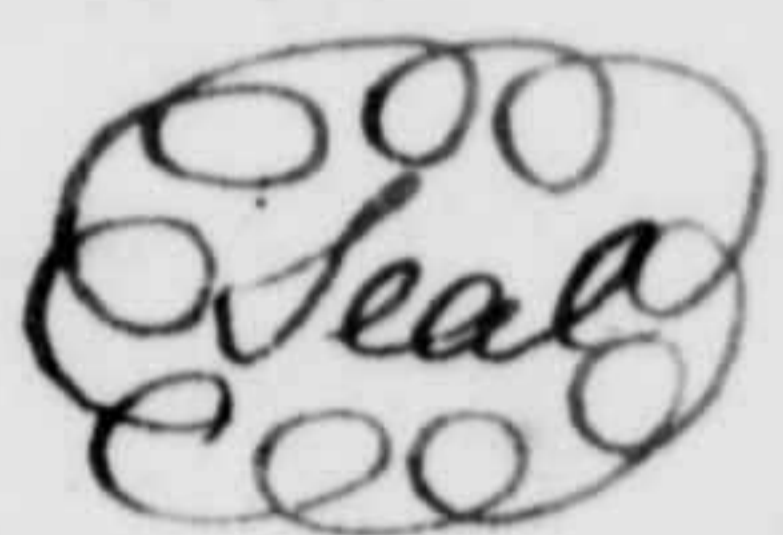
