 be enabled to take a Grant and Release of the Reversion and Inheritance of
 the same Land and Premises to him and his Heirs to such Uses Intents and
 Purposes as shall be therein Specified and declared In Witness whereof the
 Parties to these Presents have hereunto Interchangeably set their Hands and
