Bargain Sell Alien Infeoff and Confirm unto him the said Charles
Carroll his Heirs and Assigns for ever All their Estate Right Title and
Interest which they now have or hereafter at any Time may have of
and in Remainder or Remainders Reversion or Reversions in all the
several Tracts or Parcels of Land following to wit All that Tract or
Parcel of Land called the Addition Containing by Patent nine hundred and
forty Acres more or less, Three hundred Acres of Land being part of his
Lordships Kindness adjoining to the said Addition and whereon the
Dwelling House of the said Henry Darnall the Elder now Stands, And
also all that Parcel of Land called Toogood now in the Possession of the
said Henry Darnall containing One hundred Acres more or less and
also all that other Part or Parcel of Land now in the Possession of the
said Henry Darnall the Elder called and known by the Name of Pitchcroft
