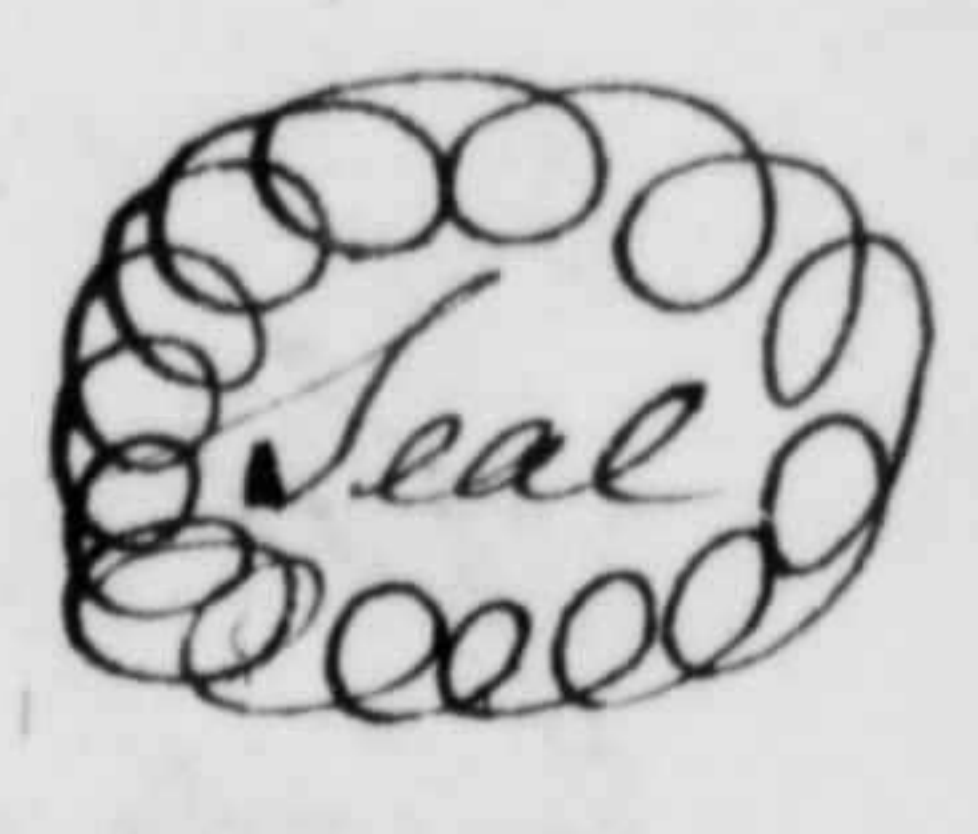

Maryland Act.

On the thirteenth day of May in the Year of our Lord Christ
One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty one came before me the Subscriber one
of his Lordships Provincial Justices the within named Richard Tilghman
Earle and did acknowledge the within Instrument of Writing to be his Act and
Deed, and the Lands and Premises therein mentioned to be the Right and Estate
of the within named Eleanor Carroll her Heirs and Assigns for ever according
to the true Intent and meaning of the same Deed and the Act of Assembly in
such Cases made and provided. And on the same day and year Ann the Wife
of the said Richard Tilghman Earle being by me privately examined apart
out of the hearing of her said Husband did acknowledge the within bargained
and sold or mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold Land and Premises
to be the Right and Estate of the within named Eleanor Carroll and the Heirs
and Assigns of the said Eleanor Carroll for ever according to the true Intent
and meaning of the within Deed and did declare and Asport that she did
make the said Acknowledgment voluntarily and freely and without being
induced thereto by fear or threats of or ill usage from her said Husband
or through fear of his displeasure —
