This Indenture made this sixth day of July one thousand seven hundred and sixty one Between Hugh Tomlinson of Frederick County Planter and David Ross Surgeon James White and Zachariah White of Prince Georges County of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Hugh Tomlinson for and in Consideration of the Sum of Thirty Pounds Current Money of Maryland to him in hand paid by the said David Ross James White Zachariah White at or before the Sealing and delivering of these Presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and therefrom doth quit exonerate and discharge the said David Ross James White and Zachariah White their Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns and every of them by these Presents Hath given granted bargained sold aliened released enfeoffed & confirmed and by these Presents doth give grant bargain sell Alien release enfeoff and confirm unto the said David Ross James White and Zachariah White their Heirs and Assigns forever all the remaining Part of a Tract of Land called Addition to Fellowship lying in Frederick County on a Branch called Rock Creek and near the Falls of the said Creek (bounded)
