Now this Indenture Witnesseth and it is hereby declared that the true Intent and meaning of all the Parties to the said Recovery and to these Presents was before and at the Time of the said Recovery and yet is that the said Recovery and the Execution thereof should and shall be and enure and be construed judged and taken to be and Enure that the said Recoverer and his Heirs should and shall stand and be seized of the Premises with the Appurtenances and of every Part and parcel thereof to the Uses Intents and Purposes herein after set down expressed and Declared and to no other Use Intent or purpose whatsoever, that is to say to the Use of the said Thomas Marsh and his Heirs and Assigns for ever.
