



" Frauds in his Majesty's Customs & for limitation of
" Officers Fees. —

I hereby Certify that on the 17th Day of March 1762
Elie Vattette one of the under Clerks of the Secretary's Office and
Provincial Court came before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships
Justices of the Peace for Ann Arundel County took the above
written Oath, and at the same Time took the several Oaths to
the Government required by Law, repeated the Test, and
Subscribed the same and Oath of Abjuration before me,
