his heirs for ever And the said Philip Jackson
doth hereby Warrant & for ever Defend the said Slaves &
their ~~present~~ increase from himself his Heirs Executors
Administrators for ever & from all other Persons whatsoever
Claiming or to Claim for the only proper use
& behoof of him the said Rachel Worthington
