now in the said County of Worcester on the South Side of
Pocomoke River on a Branch called and known by the
Name of the unrapable Branch bounded and limited as
follows, to Wit, Beginning at a marked Mul Berry
post being the original Boundary of the said Tract standing
on the North Side of the South Prong of the said Unrapable Branch
thence Running South east Two hundred poles thence East
fourteen poles, thence North thirty seven degrees East, One
