This Indenture made the seventeenth day of April in the second Year of the Reign of our most Gracious Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God King of Great Britain France and Ireland Defender of the Faith &c and in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and sixty two Between Bartholomew Comery and Joseph Janson of London in the Kingdom of Great Britain Merchants on the one part, and William Cooverfields of Prince Georges County in the Province of Maryland Merchant on the other part
