This Indenture Bipartite made
Exam^d done and concluded this Twentieth day of August in the
Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Sixty two
Between James Manning of S^t Mary's County planter
of the one part and Thomson Mason of the same County
Esquire of the other Part, Witnesseth that for and in
Consideration of five Shillings Current Money to the said
James Manning in hand paid at and before the sealing
of these Presents by him the said Thomson Mason the Receipt
whereof he the said James Manning doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof the said Thomson Mason his Executors Adm^{rs}
and Assigns doth hereby acquit exonerate and discharge
he the said James Manning hath granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain &
sell
