Priscilla Saunders of Queen Anne's County in the Province of Maryland Widow aged Seventy Years or there about being duly sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships Justices of the Provincial Court of Maryland deposeth and saith, that about Twenty one Years ago last April she was sent for as a Midwife to Mrs Peale the Wife of Mr Charles Peale then Master of the Free School in Queen Anne's County that she Delivered the said Mrs Peale of a Male Child which to the best of her Remembrance was called Charles after his Father, and that Mrs Peale said it was the first Child by Mr Peale, and further saith Not
