day of April in the Year seventeen hundred and sixty three
Between John Tyler of Charles County in Maryland Planter
of the one part James Marshall of Prince Georges County in Mary^d.
Merchant of the second part and John Rogers of Annapolis of
the third part Whereas the aforesaid John Tyler for the
Consideration of one hundred pounds Sterling to him paid by
the said James Marshall by Deed of Feoffment duly
Executed and dated the thirtieth day of March seventeen
hundred and sixty one did Confeffe him the said James
Marshall
