




1762 June 30<sup>th</sup> Review of Mr. Jacob Danner One Pound fifteen Shillings and eleven pence one Sachting holding for the use  
 of the Lord Baltimore being the Alienation Fine on the within Eight Hundred and forty eight Acres of Land by virtue of a commission  
 from Edward Lord Eg. his said Lordships agent and trustee general *Grady's Deal*

Then West fifty four perches, then South forty Degrees West, One  
 hundred & Twelve perches, then South Twenty Degrees East, Two  
 hundred & forty perches, then East Three hundred forty four perches,  
 then by a direct line to the first Rounded Trees containing & laid out  
 for eight hundred and forty Eight Acres, of Land more or less,  
 together with all and Singular its Appurtenances To have  
 and to hold the same Tract of Land called Spring plain  
 unto him the said Jacob Danner his Heirs and Assigns  
 for ever, and the said Edward, William & Henry Daniel  
 Digges do hereby covenant, and agree to Warrant, and for ever  
 defend the aforesaid Tract of Land and Premises unto the said  
 Jacob Danner his Heirs and Assigns against all persons  
 Claiming or that shall Claim any Right or Title thereto under  
 them the said Edward William and Henry Daniel Digges or  
 their Heirs In Witness whereof the parties to these  
 presents have here unto interchangeably set their hands  
 and affixed their seals the Day and Year first above written
