intituled an Act for granting a Supply of ^{Forty} Thousand Pounds
for his Majesty's Service and striking thirty four Thousand
and fifteen Pounds Six Shillings thereof in Bills of Credit,
and raising a Fund for sinking the same, and do well
and faithfully pay to the Commissioners of the Loan Office
for the Time being the several Sums of Money which he
shall receive or be answerable for, In Virtue of the same
Act, at such Times as by the said Act is directed, acor-
ding to the true Intent & Meaning thereof Then the above
Obligation to be Void & of no Effect, otherwise to remain
in full Force & Value
