Memorandum December 23. 1765 I do hereby Acknowledge to have received of John Hammond to and for the use and Benefit of my Grandson Benjamin Ogle (being at present a Minor) the Just Sum of One Hundred and fifty Pounds Sterling the same being the full Consideration or Purchase Money for Two Tracts of Land lying on Severn, Viz Hickory Ridge and Greenland each Engaged by me to said John Hammond and his heirs and which late were the Estate and Property of my Grandson aforesaid and whose Right and Title of in and to the same and each of them with Every of their appurtenances were on application in his Behalf to the General Assembly reciting my Engagement aforesaid of the same to said John Hammond and for the Sum aforesaid being one hundred and fifty Pounds Sterling and hereby Acknowledge to be the said aforesaid Transferred to and Vested in the said John Hammond his heirs and Assigns for Ever to and for his and Their sole and proper use and behoof by and in Virtue of a private Act of Assembly for such and other purposes therein mentioned passed at November session, one Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty five.
