This Indenture made this Twenty Sixth Day of October in the Year  
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Sixty Six Between John Whips  
 of Ann Arundell County Planter of the one part and Thomas Selman of  
 Baltimore County Planter of the other Part Witnesseth That he the said  
 John Whips for and in consideration of the Sum of Thirty Seven pounds Ten  
 Shillings Current Money to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Selman  
 at or before the Ensealing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof  
 the said John Whips doth hereby Acknowledge and hereof doth Acquit discharge  
 and fully Discharge the said Thomas Selman his heir and Assigns forever  
 Hath Given Granted Bargained and Sold and by these Presents doe give Grant  
 Bargain Sell Alienate Enfeoff and Confirm unto him the said Thomas  
 Selman his heir and Assigns for ever all that Tract or Parcell of Land  
 being part of a Tract of Land Called and known by the Name of the  
 Additional Progress lying and being in Ann Arundel County and Balti-  
 more County Beginning for the said Tract or Parcell of Land in Baltimore  
 County at a Four Notched Red Oak Sapling Standing at the End of the  
 North Forty Three Degrees west Twenty Perche Line of the aforesaid  
 Progress and Running Thence and Bounding on the Origin all Survey the  
 said following Courses Viz<sup>t</sup> North Six Degrees and half East Sixty perches  
 (North
